MCS Students in K-12 will work in groups to create innovative solutions to this year's design challenge question posed by the Ohio STEM Learning Network (OSLN): How might you re-imagine SMART mobility in your community to increase your community's happiness and well-being?

OSLN defines SMART Mobility as the use of nascent technologies to improve the mobility of people and goods from point A to point B in a safe, cost-effective, convenient way, focusing on solutions that are connected, user-friendly, and intelligent. Examples of applied SMART mobility range from on-demand ride services to autonomous vehicles.

This design challenge will begin with a Kick-Off Event on February 7th, 2020 and culminate with a Student Design Showcase on April 16th, 2020.

Dear Business Partner,

Richland Public Health and the Ohio Department of Health (ODH), in coordination with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), is closely monitoring the 2019 novel (new) coronavirus first identified in Wuhan, Hubei Province, China. The first case in the United States was announced January 21, 2020 in Washington state, and cases have been confirmed in multiple states since then.

The United States started screening travelers arriving from Wuhan on January 17, 2020. CDC staff screen travelers from China at 20 U.S. airports with quarantine stations. ODH notifies Richland Public Health if a person coming to our county has had contact with a confirmed case of 2019-nCoV. There are currently no cases of 2019-nCoV in Ohio (as of February 3, 2020). Although this is a rapidly evolving situation, the threat to the general public in the US is considered low.

If your employee would come in contact with a person who has been diagnosed with 2019 novel coronavirus (2019-nCoV), Richland Public Health would ask that employee to stay home and self-monitor for fever and symptoms such as cough and shortness of breath, for 14 days since their last contact with the 2019-nCoV patient. Your employee's cooperation is necessary to protect your workplace and the rest of the public. The steps s/he must take can be an inconvenience but are important and essential.

We are recommending that employers allow exposed employees to work from home whenever possible. It is very important that the employee not travel during this period. The sacrifices your company would be making to keep all Richland County residents safe would be appreciated by Richland Public Health.

If your employees have questions or concerns about 2019 novel coronavirus (2019-nCoV), please remind them that their risk is very low. The best preventive steps for any communicable disease include simple but important measures to practice as part of a daily routine, especially during flu season:

- Wash your hands for 20 seconds or more with soapy water. If unavailable, use hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands.
- Stay home while you are sick (except to visit a healthcare professional) and avoid close contact with others.
- Cover your mouth/nose with a tissue or sleeve when coughing or sneezing.
- Get adequate sleep and eat well-balanced meals to ensure a healthy immune system.

Richland Public Health will continue to prepare for, screen, and prevent the spread of illness to keep our community safe. Please feel free to call our Public Health Nursing staff (419) 774-4540 if you have any questions.

Blood Pressure Reading Cost: FREE


This simple check screens for hypertension (high blood pressure) and hypotension (low blood pressure).* High blood pressure is a risk factor for cardiovascular disease.



Blood Sugar Check Cost: FREE

(3-hour fast preferred)

This blood test screens for hyperglycemia (high blood sugar) and hypoglycemia (low blood sugar). One cause of high blood sugar is diabetes.*



Anemia Check Cost: FREE

With a small fingerstick, two blood tests (hemoglobin and hematocrit) check on red blood cells. Low hemoglobin and/or hematocrit can be a sign of anemia.*



Cholesterol Check Cost: \$12.00. Cash or check only. (Requires 9-12-hour fast)

With a small fingerstick, two blood tests (hemoglobin and hematocrit) check on red blood cells. Low hemoglobin and/or hematocrit can be a sign of anemia.*



Education and Referrals Cost: FREE




