- South Park and North Lake Park: Tuesday, October 16th, meet at the South Park Pavilion @ 9 am.



What is it?

Number '1' in the State

There are few among us who doesn't have some relationship, direct or indirect, with the dreaded disease cancer in one of its myriad forms. In our community we are blessed to have a specialty center of the No. 2 Hospital in the nation, and No. 1 in Ohio which is the Cleveland Clinic Cancer Center. These ranking

reflect the results of an objective compilation of various indicators by U.S. News and World Report for its "Best Hospitals 2018-2019".

Cleveland Clinic is a nonprofit multispecialty academic medical center integrating clinical and hospital care with research and education. It was founded in 1921 with the vision of providing outstanding patient care based on the principles of cooperation, compassion and innovation.

Since 2013 Cleveland Clinic has operated its Cancer Center, located on Aspira Court (off of S. Trimble Road), with approximately 50 physicians, nurses, and other support staff. They provide services in chemotherapy, infusion, radiation therapy, PET/CT scans, and genetic testing, to name a few. They also provide nutritional counseling, support groups and art therapy for both patients and caregivers. There is a retail pharmacy for your added convenience. Access to the Center is through physician or self-referral. They are affiliated with Avita Health Systems for cancer treatment.

The Cancer Center is active in the community, as one of the sponsors of the 'Bruce A. Waite Mile for Meso (mesothelioma) 5K Run/Walk' held recently in Ontario and a participant in the 'Minority Health Fair' at Ocie Hill Neighborhood Center. Increasing awareness of their services is a goal for the Center.
