Meet Katherine Talbott

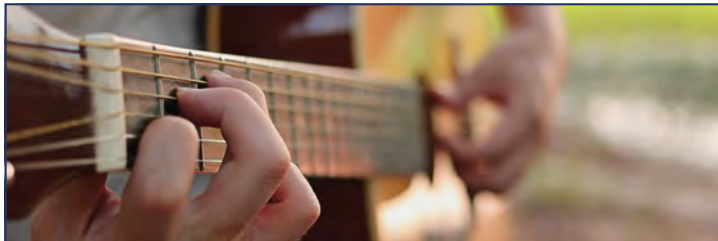
Digital Media Marketing Intern at the Chamber

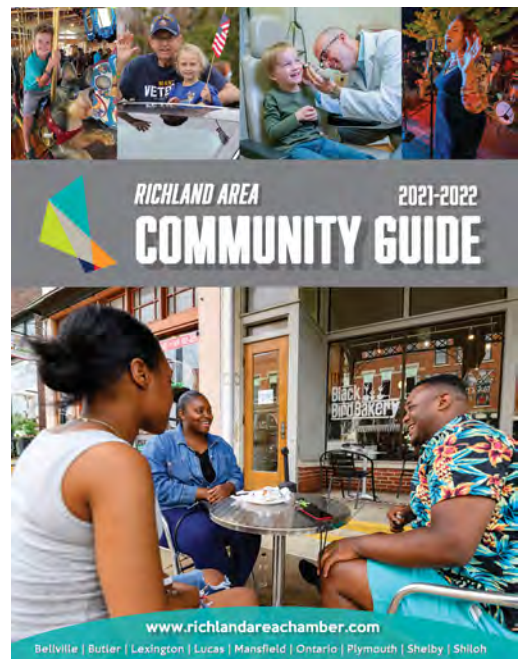

About The New Store

The organization was formed in 1996 under the name The Richland County Children Services Auxiliary. It began when community minded individuals desired to help the children associated with Richland County Children Services receive Christmas gifts.

The original organization served as an Auxiliary to Richland County Children Services for 10 years, providing Christmas gifts, school supplies, lessons, camperships, and many extras requested by caseworkers to support children under the care and supervision of the agency.

In 2007, the organization decided to take on the service that had been provided at The Store on Diamond Street for years. The Richland County Children Services Auxiliary was dissolved and legally changed to Richland County Children's Auxiliary, reflecting that the organization would serve children throughout Richland County, not just those affiliated with Richland County Children Services.

The New Store opened in September 2007 adopting many of the same procedures that had been used at The Store. The New Store moved to its current location inside the Mid-Ohio Educational Service Center building in February 2011.

Do they even know you?

In our current situation, it seems that many job seekers are stepping outside of their pre-pandemic industries and attempting to spread their wings. They're looking for something new, with new responsibilities, autonomy, and flexibility. On the national level, there's a mixture of job seekers who are applying for jobs where they don't really meet the "qualifications", and then there are others who are applying to jobs where they are "overqualified". This trend seems to be most common in metropolitan areas.

Locally - I'm hearing that employers just aren't seeing the normal flow of applications. There are help wanted signs on nearly every door, sign-on bonuses advertised on billboards, and wages are going up across the board. This makes me wonder: are we fishing with the right bait? Are we even in the right pond?

Over the last 5 years, we've taken deep dives into the generational gaps, trends, and characteristics. We've talked about wage increases and the importance of benefits. But I'm wondering if the message is just simply falling short.

Many successful companies are effectively utilizing a variety of media outlets to tell their story: engaging videos on their website and Youtube, Facebook Stories that roll out daily, Instagram Reels...and yes, even Tik Tok. I'm not suggesting that it's all about the platform - I'm suggesting that it's about your story.

What does your company do best? How do you do it best? Is there innovation or technology involved? What's the work community like at your company? What does the work look like? When does the work happen?

These are the things that maybe, just maybe we're missing.

These are the things we're trying with this year's Employa-palooza Job Fair on August 21st. We have identified a few social media platforms that we feel we can manage, and we're going after a specific audience by trying to tell the story of this event - and the stories of the employers who will be participating. We're not saying it's the magic solution - but it's another tool in the tool box!
