Recovery and Business Coalition Participants Needed

Richland County over the past 2 years, as a direct result of COVID and the myriad of societal and financial impacts COVID has created, has seen a significant rise in behavioral health concerns, including spikes in suicide, overdoses, deaths from stress related illnesses and high rates of individuals seeking assistance from private agencies. Although these issues are occurring across the demographic continuum, two factors have a higher impact: age range of 30-55 and most of these individuals are currently or have been recently gainfully employed.

We would like to form a Recovery and Business Coalition made up of employers and the behavioral health community to develop strategies to positively impact the current concerns. We would like to establish regular meetings where we can provide training and good information for employers in working with employees that may be showing signs and symptoms of distress. In addition, these meetings will provide an opportunity for employers to tell treatment providers what hard and soft skills need to be developed to give people in recovery from a mental illness or an addiction the greatest opportunity for success in the workplace.

We know that Richland County has a significant number of positions that are unfilled. Behavioral health agencies have a lot of people who are at a point in time in their recovery that gainful employment will advance them to the next level. This coalition can be a great opportunity to build something positive at the crossroads between Work and Recovery.

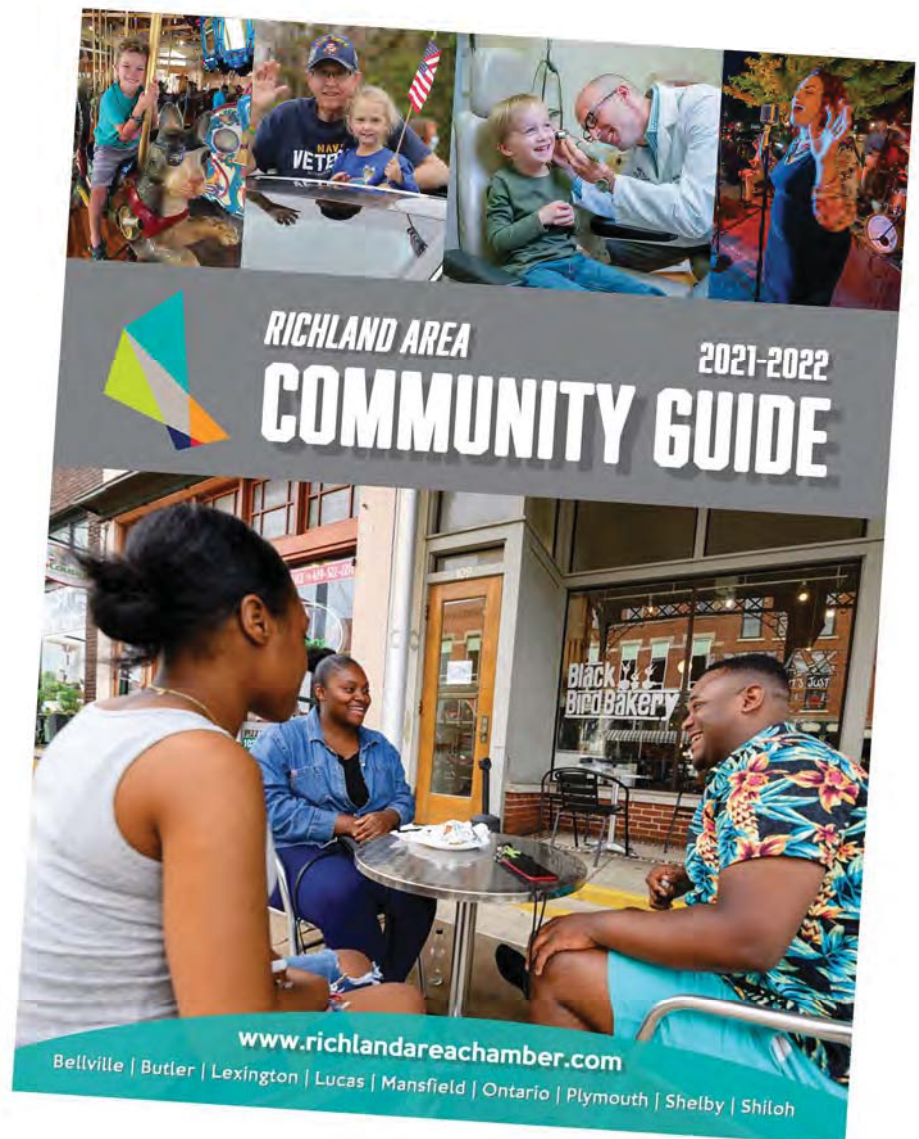

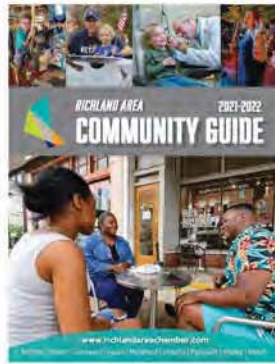

Coronavirus Update

1. **The Vaccination and Booster** are highly effective in keeping you and others safe.
2. **Masks** are recommended if:
 - you are in a Community with Level High Transmission
 - you are or someone you are near has a weakened immune system or is ill
