The Ohio Revised Code provides a wide range of abilities for Port Authorities, including but not limited to providing sales tax exemptions on approved projects, owning land, setting fees, and levying taxes. Port Authorities support community and economic development goals by helping catalyze additional private sector development and can provide financial assistance for a wide range of public and private projects. 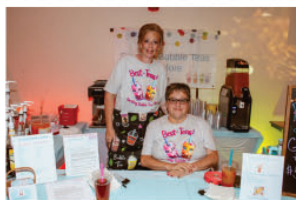

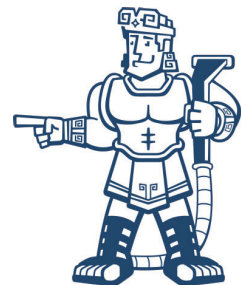

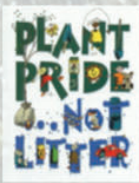
Class of 2025 Commencement

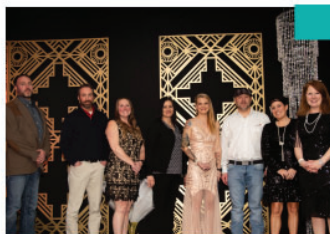

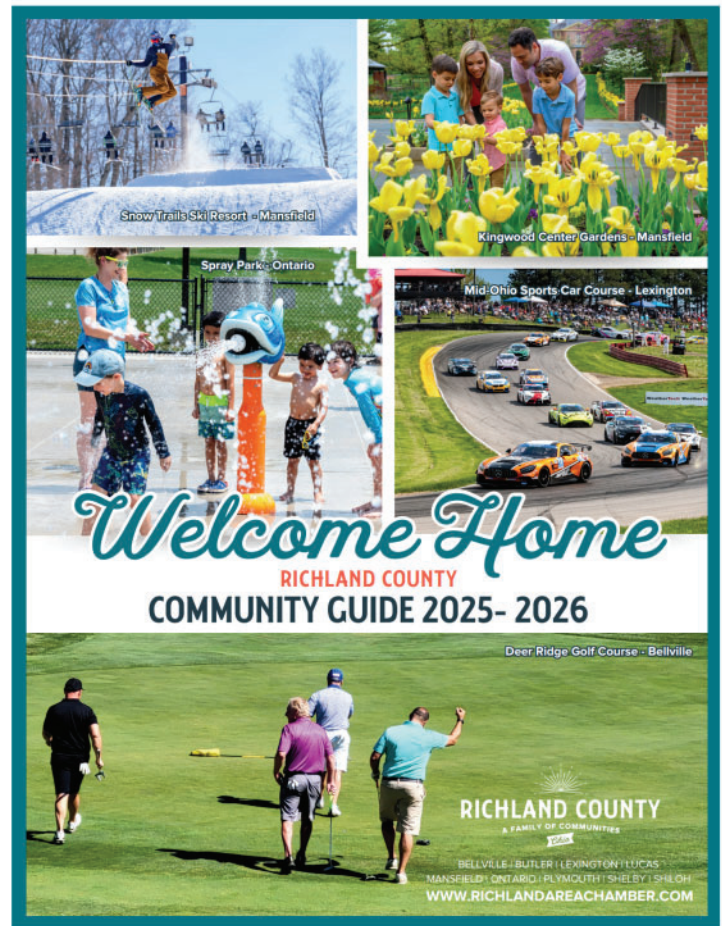

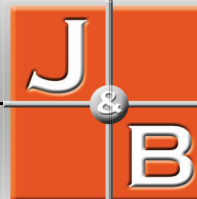
